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Town of Washington 9th Annual Catfish Festival Cook-Off Rules & Regulations

Date: March 16, 2008

Location: Washington Festival Grounds Exit 25 Veterans Memorial Blvd, Washington, La.

Entry Fee: \$50.00

Judging: Each contestant will provide judges with (1) sample of their contest entry (couvillion) at 11:00 a.m. to be judged.

Setup Time: Contestants should bring equipment, supplies, etc, on Sunday morning between 7:00-8:00 a.m.

Registration: Contestants must register with Contest Committee Members on Sunday morning no later than 9:00 a.m.

Awards: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place plaques will be awarded.

1. Contestants must provide butane cookers and other supplies needed for cooking Catfish Couvillion. No ground fires will be allowed. Contestants must provide all their equipment, tables, chairs, team name signs, decorations, etc. needed by the team.
2. All cooking must be done in booth at contest site.
3. Contestants must prepare at least 10 lbs. of their contest entry. No other seafood may be added. Catfish stock may be added.
4. Contestants must provide a sample of their cuisine to the contest committee for judging. A container will be provided for samples. No name or identification is to be placed on the container by contestants.
5. Each entry will be assigned an identification number and all judging will be done by identification number only. Decision of the judges is final.
6. Judging results will be announced from the stage as soon as possible.
7. Ice chests may be used for food only. All beverages must be purchased from festival authorized booths.
8. Head Chef/Cook will be responsible for conduct of their team members and guests. The Head Chef/Cook is also responsible for keeping areas clean. Please bring trash bags. All cooking equipment must be removed from cooking site by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.
9. Contestants are asked to donate their cuisine to the Festival. Rice will be cooked and sold by the Festival for \$2.00 per bowl. All proceeds will go to the Washington Municipal Public Library.

Judges will allow a maximum of 50 points:

Taste..... 30 Points (Maximum)

Color 40 Points (Maximum)

Consistency 10 Points (Maximum)

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
